

Managing Conflict of Interests with Sportsbet

Sportsbet takes Conflicts of Interest seriously

Sportsbet is committed to acting professionally, fairly and with integrity in all of its business dealings. This includes ensuring that any Conflicts of Interest (defined below) affecting Sportsbet are identified, and properly managed so that they do not negatively affect Sportsbet's services, activities or decisions.

Therefore, we're asking Sportsbet's third party service providers for their assistance.

What is a Conflict of Interest with Sportsbet?

Sportsbet considers that someone has a "**Conflict of Interest**" in relation to Sportsbet if in the provision of goods or services to Sportsbet, they may be, or may appear to be, improperly influenced by any additional interest that they may have over and above the business relationship between the parties.

This includes situations where there is no actual existing conflict but there may be a 'potential' conflict or a 'perceived' conflict, such as where you have obligations to any third parties that may jeopardise the proper performance of your obligations to Sportsbet.

What happens if there is a Conflict of Interest?
